The Fair Parade operates under the General Rules & Regulations of the 2009 Pasco County Fair. A copy of the Fair Rules and Regulations is available upon request.

**Initial Lineup will be made based upon entries received by Friday, February 5<sup>th</sup>.**

**DEADLINE FOR ALL ENTRIES WILL BE 5 P.M. ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 12<sup>TH</sup>. UNITS NOT OFFICIALLY ENTERED BY THE DEADLINE DATE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED IN COMPETITION.** Initial line up will be made based upon entries sent by Friday, Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>. The completed entry is to be returned to the **PASCO COUNTY FAIR PARADE COMMITTEE, 36722 S. R. 52, Dade City, FL 33525.**

Each official entry will receive by return mail or phone from the Parade Committee the following:

- a. **Information on the parade route, locating assembly points other pertinent information.**
- b. **A number to denote position in the parade. Each entry is responsible for posting this number on the left side of the entry unit, so the judges may distinguish the unit. Entries not clearly displaying a number will not be considered in competition by the judges. (Bands and marching units are not required to display the number if otherwise identified by banner or signs.**

Lining up for the parade will begin at 11 a.m. All floats and large units should be in their designated assembly points by 12:30 p.m. and persons riding floats must be in position by **12:30 p.m.**

**The parade will commence at 1 p.m., Monday, February 15, 2010.** Any unit not prepared to move when called upon by the parade marshal may be held to the end of the parade. **No undecorated commercial vehicles** will be allowed in the parade. No unit nor part of a unit may stop during the parade. **All units must move forward when possible** and shall not impede the progress of the parade at any time. All units must obey directions of the parade marshals and must remain in the line of march to the disbanding point. Failure to do so may result in removal from parade and competition.

**Please note:** The throwing of candy or other articles from parade or personal vehicles as well as by any parade participants in **NOT** allowed. Also, all riders of horses must provide scoopers for clean-up following their units.

Parade entry forms shall be marked to show in what category a unit wishes to compete. A unit may compete in one category **ONLY**. The Parade Committee reserves the right to change category classifications to allow for proper competition between the units. All entries will compete for best unit depicting **"HOW SWEET IT IS"** parade theme.

Judging will be done by a panel of impartial persons, selected by the Parade Committee. Decisions of the judges are final. The winners will be contacted by telephone by the chairperson.
