

Pasco County Fair Youth Rabbit & Cavy Show – 2010

- 1. ELIGIBILITY** – All Pasco County Youth (K-12) are invited to exhibit their rabbit(s) and cavy. Any combination of males and females may be entered as long as the total number of rabbits does not exceed three (3), and cavy does not exceed one (1). Pre-registration is required. All rabbits and cavy must be in the possession of the exhibitor by December 19, 2009. **Exhibitors must read and understand Pasco County Fair General Rules located at www.pascocountyfair.com.** These rules include Safe Handling Practices, IAFE National Code of Show Ethics, and The Livestock Addendum.
- 2. IDENTIFICATION-** All rabbits entered into the show must be permanently tattooed in the **LEFT** ear. Absolutely **NO** tattooing will be done on fairground property if you need help with tattooing please contact a committee member or Rennie Stevens at 727-378-7766. Any rabbit who's tattoo does not match the number given on the entry form will not be allowed entry.
- 3. ENTRY DEADLINE-** Entry forms must be submitted to the Youth Rabbit committee at the Pasco County Fair Office by January 15, 2010, or postmarked (not metered mail) On that date. Exhibitors that fail to properly submit entry forms by the January 15th deadline may enter upon payment of a \$20.00 **Late Entry Fee** by the late entry deadline of **January 29, 2010**. Entries must be hand delivered to the fair office, not mailed. **No entries will be accepted after the entry deadline.** No substitutions can be made after the entry deadline. There will be a \$2.00 entry fee for each rabbit and cavy entering the show, and must be submitted with the entry form. A total of 5 points can be earned for a correctly completed entry form. An incomplete or inaccurate entry form will be returned. Entry Forms **MUST** be filled out by the exhibitor.
- 4. ACCEPTABLE BREEDS-** Only breeds recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Association in its standard of perfection will be accepted for entry. See WWW.arba.net/ breed descriptions.
- 5. Rabbit and Cavy Seminar** – Exhibitors are encouraged (but not required) to attend the Rabbit and Cavy Seminar presented by the Pasco County Fair Rabbit and Cavy Committee. Best Over All Exhibitor points will be awarded to those Exhibitors that attend the seminar at **Clayton Hall Friday, October 16, 2009 at 6:30 pm**. This seminar will help inform you with questions about your rabbit and/or cavy record book, obtaining a show quality rabbit and/or cavy, tattoo if needed, hands on handling, grooming, feeding, demonstrating showmanship and

any other information which is needed. There will be a quiz at the end of the seminar. Points will be awarded for this seminar only.

6. **ARRIVAL AT FAIR-** Rabbits and cavy must arrive between the hours of 1:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 14, 2010 **Vehicles will not be allowed on the fair midway or near the barns during Check In or Check Out.** The EXHIBITOR must cage all of his or her rabbits or cavy. All rabbits and cavy must be transported in a cage or pet carrier. **Cardboard boxes are not allowed.** No sick, diseased or animals showing evidence of parasites will be allowed in the rabbit and cavy show. Health Regulation will be enforced by the committee according to Chapter 5C-4 via Florida Administration Code entitled " Admission of Animals for Exhibition". **Also see Pasco County Fair general Rules on safe Handling Practices located at www.pascocountyfair.com** . Rabbits and cavy presented at any other time will not be accepted.
7. **CAVY-** All cavy **MUST be in a leak proof carry cage (plastic or wire made).** **Cages are not to exceed the measurements of 10 inches tall x 12 inches x 12 inches.** Exhibitor's names must be clearly written on the bottom of the cage. Exhibitors must bring water bottles and food bowls for their cavy. **Clasps may be used to secure the cage; however, locks are not allowed.**
8. **JUDGING-** Judging will be Monday, February 15, 2010. Judging will begin at 1:00 P.M. starting with cavy, with rabbits following. Exhibitors are permitted and **encouraged** (but not required) to be present during judging. The decision of the Judges will be final. The barn will remain closed until the judges results are official. Results will be posted as soon as possible after judging. The decision of the judges will be final.
9. **SHOWMANSHIP-** Exhibitors are encouraged (but not required) to participate.
 - A. Competition time will be February 15th at 9:00 A.M.
 - B. Youth must sign up for showmanship on the entry form.
 - C. Exhibitors will demonstrate showmanship skills on an individual basis to a judge.
 - D. Judging will be on a modified Danish System
 - E. A Strip Ribbon will be awarded to all participating exhibitors according to their score,
 - F. Each Grade Division will receive a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Rosette
Grades K-2 Grade 3-5 Grade 6-8 Grade 9-12
10. **RECORD BOOKS-** All exhibitors are required to enter a rabbit or cavy record book for competition. Rabbit and cavy record books are available online at www.pascocountyfair.com. Answers to the questions on the Questionnaire page may be found on line or in the 4-H Rabbit Work books. These books are located at the University of Florida IFASA Extension Office in Dade City. The 4 book set may be purchased online at www.4-hmall.org. (Click on books/ curricula/ plants & animals/ rabbit). Record books must be submitted at the time of check-in on February 14, 2010. Record books will be judged on a modified Danish System. Each exhibitor

will be receiving a strip ribbon based on their score. In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker will be decided upon by a third party judge.

- 11. POSTER CONTEST-** Exhibitors may enter the rabbit or cavy poster contest. The poster **MUST** promote rabbits or cavy and educate fair goers about rabbits or cavy and /or the rabbit industry. All posters must be designed on or affixed to regular poster board whose dimensions are not larger than **14" x 22"**. Any previously used poster may not be submitted. Posters using computer assistance to create components of the poster or the poster itself **MUST** affix a statement of one paragraph explaining how the computer assistance affected the posters and visual presentation. **THE EXHIBITORS NAME, AND GRADE MUST BE ON THE BOTTOM RIGHT CORNER OF THE BACK OF THE POSTER.** Posters must be submitted at check-in on February 14, 2010. Posters will be judged on a modified Danish System. Each exhibitor will be receiving a strip ribbon based on their score.
- 12. RABBIT DECORATING CONTEST-** This is a picture of a rabbit that can be found with the rules for the Rabbit and Cavy Show.

 - A. Exhibitors names must be written on the back of the picture
 - B. Pictures must be decorated by the exhibitor
 - C. Exhibitors may enter only one picture
 - D. Pictures must be turned in at check in
 - E. Pictures may be decorated with materials, paint, colors, beads, etc.
 - F. The fair will dispose of any pictures left after February 22th, 2010
- 13. Animal Information Card:** - Exhibitors are encouraged (but not required) to create information card telling the general public about their rabbits and cavy, (name of, breed, what they eat, etc.) Exhibitors will receive 10 extra points towards the Best Display Award. For the protection of the exhibitors, personal information, such as, addresses, phone numbers, etc., are not allowed. Exhibitors must put their name, grade and the breed of the animal on the back of the card. **Cards may not be larger than 4"x 5"**.
- 14. ASK ME BOOTH-** Exhibitors may sign up for **one- hour intervals** during the fair to stay at the Ask Me Booth. Exhibitors will answer general questions from the fair going public in an informative and polite manner. All exhibitors **must sign in and out** to obtain their full points. A maximum of three (3) hours per exhibitor may be worked. Each hour, up until 5 p.m. on Friday, February 20, 2010, will result in the exhibitor earning 10 points towards Best Display.
- 15. DURING THE FAIR-** Rabbits and cavy will be fed and watered by a designated person during the fair. Neither that person nor the Fair Association will be held responsible for any injury or

loss of any rabbit. Also see Pasco County fair General Rules Livestock Addendum located at www.pascocountyfair.com

16. AWARDS- Awards will be presented at the Awards Ceremony held behind the Poultry and Rabbit barn at **6:30 p.m. on Friday February 19, 2010.**

Rabbits: Best of Breed and Best Opposite sex of breed will receive a mini rosette.

Best in show, first runner up, and second runner up will receive a trophy.

Cavy : Best of breed and best opposite sex of breed will receive a mini rosette.

Best in show and reserve will receive a trophy

RECORD BOOKS, POSTER and SHOWMANSHIP

All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place winners will receive a Rosette
Grades K-2 Grades 3-5 Grades 6-8 Grades 9-12

RABBIT DECORATING CONTEST

There will be **two** Divisions, K-5th Grade and 6-12th Grade. Each division will receive: Rosette for 1st 2nd, 3rd place.

BEST RABBIT AND CAVY DISPLAY

Exhibitors will compete together and be judged on the number of rabbits or cavy, ribbons and points received. Additional Points are achieved by participation in the Seminar, Record Book, Poster Contest, Ask Me Booth, Showmanship Decorated Rabbit Contest, Information cards, Fair Membership and correctly filling out the entry form. There will be one Best Over All Trophy awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to the winner of each Age group. K-2, 3-5, 6-8, & 9-12

PREMIUMS- Will is paid on Divisions only. Premiums are judged on Showmanship, Record Book, Poster Contest, Rabbit Decorating Contest, and Information Cards. A premium will also be paid on Best Display for each division.

Premiums will be paid as follows:

Blue ----\$5.00 Red-----\$4.00 White-----\$3.00 Best Display will receive a \$10.00 premium.

Exhibitors will compete in divisions as follows: Division 1 = K-2, Division 2 = 3-5, Division 3 = 6-8, Division 4 = 9-12 (Grades)

In case of a tie their will be a questionnaire pertaining to Showmanship.

17. RELEASE FROM FAIR- CAVY must be picked up Wednesday, February 17, 2010 between 6:00p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Rabbits must be picked up **Sunday February 21, 2010** between the hours of **5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.** Any rabbit left after 8:00 p.m. on February 21, 2010 will become the

property of the Fair Association. In case of emergency please call before the time deadline, fair office (352) 567-6678 **Any Exhibitor picking up their rabbits before 5:00 p.m. will forfeit all premiums.**

- 18. PASSES-** In the spirit of supporting our fair, the Rabbit and Cavy Committee encourages families of exhibitors to purchase a family pass for the Pasco County Fair. This pass will allow all members of the family to enter the fair on a daily basis throughout the length of the fair. No passes will be sold in the month of February. An Additional 15 points will be awarded to each exhibitor with proof of a family membership
- 19. Grievances:** An appeals committee composed of the Fair Ag. Committee shall receive and act upon any grievance arising out of an event. The grievance must be filed in writing and accompanied by \$25.00 cash deposit. If the grievance is overruled, the deposit shall be forfeited to the fair. **Decision of judges are final and are not subject to protest**
