

Guinness Book of World Records™

Join us at the 23rd annual Pasco Bug Jam as we attempt to reclaim our title in The Guinness Book of World Records™ for the most people crammed into an old VW Bug. We broke the record of 15 set in 2008 in Brazil at the 2009 Bug Jam when 17 stuffed into an old Volkswagen Beetle. But that record was also short-lived when 20 persons affiliated with Asbury University in Kentucky crammed into a VW Bug in December 2010. If you want to be a part of The Guinness Book of World Records™ attempt, register between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. at the entertainment stage at the Bug Jam on Sunday, Nov. 13, 2011. Participants must pay Bug Jam admission. At meeting will be held with those registered at 2 p.m. to determine who would be best suited and a strategy for packing into the Bug.

Rules

1. All participants must pay gate admission to the Bug Jam or otherwise be on the premises as a show entrant, vendor, or Bug Jam official.
2. All participants must be 18 or older.
3. All participants must be 5 feet or taller.
4. All participants must remain in the Bug for 5 seconds with the doors & windows closed & no body parts protruding from vehicle.
5. All participants must sign the participant's release form.

Bug Regulations

6. The Bug must be a standard production model.
7. All seats, steering wheel, gear shift, mirror and other interior items must remain in place.
8. All windows and doors must be closed and remained closed for 5 second with all arms and legs of participants inside.
